Locker Room

Middle School & High School

The middle school and high school locker room gives students a place to store their clothing and personal belongings while they participate in gym class or after-school sports. It may also be used as a place where coaches can meet with their students before a practice or game to review a strategy or develop new plays. The locker room often includes an office space for the gym teacher or coach, and storage space for sports equipment. Locking storage ensures individual students have a place to safely store personal sports equipment, clothing, uniforms or belongings as needed, and benches give students a place to sit as they get ready for practice or meet with their teammates and coaches.

Requirements for a Great Locker Room

For **students**, the locker room should provide them with a space to securely store belongings and change clothing before and after gym class or sports practice. A seating area should be available for students to gather with teammates or a coach for strategy sessions. Equipment storage should be easily accessible.

For **teachers and coaches**, the locker room should be equipped with ample storage for balls, bats, gloves, uniforms, goal posts and other sports equipment. A personal workspace provides the gym teacher with a place to keep their personal belongings, plan classes or practice sessions, and store paperwork such as permission forms or medical releases.

For **administrators**, the locker room should be furnished in a way that meets the needs of their school's physical education department. Products must be readily available and delivered on time. Installation should be quick and efficient.

The **changing area** provides students with secure storage for their personal belongings, as well as a comfortable space where they can change before and after gym class or team practice.

- Athletic lockers are ventilated to reduce odors and help prevent the growth of mold or mildew. Recessed handles accommodate removable combination locks, allowing school personnel to remove the locks if needed, without damaging the locker unit.
- Combination locks can be reused and reassigned to different lockers as needed. Lost or damaged combination locks can be easily replaced.
- Locker room benches offer students a place to sit as they change for gym class or meet with their teammates or a coach for planning sessions.

The **gathering area** acts as a space where students can meet with their teammates or coach to talk strategy or team goals. This area may also be used to store student-accessible PE equipment such as balls, cones, practice jerseys and other items.

- A mobile **dry-erase board** can be used to plan plays, demonstrate a concept or create a checklist. Rolling casters make it easy to move around the locker room space.
- Several **waste baskets** in the area give students a place to dispose of gum, used hand wraps and other trash, ensuring the space stays clean and tidy.
- An equipment storage cart makes it easy for students to access practice jerseys, goal posts, balls, bats, gloves and other sports equipment.

The **office area** gives the gym teacher or coach a place to comfortably do paperwork, store files, or meet with individual students.

- A teacher's desk stores personal belongings and keeps files such as permission slips and medical releases organized. A wide worksurface accommodates a computer or laptop.
- The mobile **office chair** features a padded seat and back to ensure teachers stay comfortable as they work. Rolling casters make it easy to move around the workspace as needed.
- A lockable filing cabinet keeps medical releases and other confidential files secure and organized.
- The wall-mount dry-erase board gives teachers and coaches a place to write down notes and reminders
 or to create schedules and team rosters.
- A bulletin board allows the teacher or coach to pin flyers, memos, schedules or any other items that may need to remain posted for a longer period of time.

- A waste basket provides a place where to dispose trash during the workday.
- A wall clock ensures students, teachers, and coaches are on time for various PE activities and events.
