



Outdoor Common Area

Elementary School

- A **bike rack** gives students a place where they can store and lock up bikes during school hours.
- An **outdoor storage box** holds sports equipment or outdoor toys. It may also be used by the school's maintenance staff to store landscaping tools instead.

The **communication area** conveys information about upcoming events to students and parents.

- An **outdoor message board** can be used by teachers or school administrators to post messages and information about school events or special programs.
- A **raised garden bed** located near the message board helps parents and students take notice of the area, encouraging them to read any posted communication.
