For **administrators**, the video creation space should be furnished to meet the goal of their facility. Products must be readily available and delivered on time. Installation should be quick and efficient.

Mobile stools are easy to move around the room and can be pushed underneath tables when more space is needed.

Mobile dry erase easels can be moved to student planning areas for brainstorming sessions.

Mobile storage equipment makes it easy to move project supplies around the room. This area includes:

- **Mobile bin storage**

- **Open shelving**
- **Lockable storage**
- **Mobile charging carts**

Mobile bin storage keeps lenses, filters and other videography supplies organized. Plastic bins can be removed from the cart for use at student workstations.

Open shelving organizes larger equipment and props.

Lockable storage secures expensive equipment or items that require teacher supervision.

Mobile charging carts keep classroom devices secure and ready for use. Rolling casters make it easy to move the cart around the room and a textured surface provides students with an extra workspace for cameras and other recording equipment.
